Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 4 items:

1. Your report contains incorrect Column B figures for Lines 17(a), 17(e), 22, 23, 28(a), 28(d), 29 and 30 of the Summary and Detailed Summary Page information. When aggregating and reporting receipts and disbursements, candidate committees are required to disclose their activity on an election-cycle basis, from 11/3/04 to 11/4/08. Please amend your report to show election cycle-to-date figures for all aggregate amounts. (2 U.S.C. § 434(b))
2. The loan payment for First Bank of South Jeffco disclosed on Schedule B-P does not equal the loan payment itemized on Schedule C-P for the First Bank of South Jeffco. Each loan payment made by the committee must be itemized on Schedule B-P regardless of the amount of the payment. Please correct this discrepancy and file an amendment to your report. (11 CFR § 104.3(b)(4)(iii))
3. Commission Regulations require the continuous reporting of all outstanding loans. This report omits the loans itemized on your previous report(s) (11 CFR §§ 104.3(d) and 104.11). Please amend your report(s) to indicate the current status of the following loans:

Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
